Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Welcome back indoors! Beginning August 7, we return to indoor worship. It appears that the spread of Covid is so prevalent that it seems little can be done to prevent it – certainly not worshipping outdoors, as several of our members have contracted it and additional members continue to test positive. We encourage everyone to remain vigilant, nonetheless – respect others’ desires for distance, be aware of your own symptoms, and please don’t worship indoors if you have symptoms.

To facilitate worship for as many as possible, our 10:30 service will be conducted indoors with regular seating. We will also set up the speakers outdoors for those who prefer to worship on the lawn. We will also broadcast on FM 88.1 for those who choose to stay in their vehicle. And, of course, we will be on Facebook Live. All these options will continue to apply to our 10:30 worship until there is no demand for the outdoor options. Our 8:00 service will be indoors only, with no other options at that hour.

While the vast majority of cases now include only minor symptoms, we should not take that for granted. A close friend of one of our members is suffering significant complications despite being fully vaccinated and boosted (both lower lungs collapsed and more). Please be respectful of others’ decisions regarding their personal preferences.

Our Ministry Expansion Committee has begun their work. Our work in our Sunday Bible study gave them a wealth of ideas to begin with, and I am confident that those will only be the beginning of new opportunities for sharing the Gospel in word and deed. I look forward to their reports to Council and the new ministries that Holy Lamb will undertake in the months to come.

Kathy and I will be flying (fully masked) to Colorado on Sunday afternoon, July 31 for 2 weeks. In my absence Rev. Steve Vogt will be preaching on Aug. 7 and 14. He will also be available in case of an emergency need for pastoral care. Please contact him at (973) 919-5539. He and Caren are also in our new photo directory.

Kathy and I look forward to hearing your voices as we worship with you via Facebook on Aug. 7; and we will be with you in person on the 14th (subject to the airlines), though I will not be preaching.

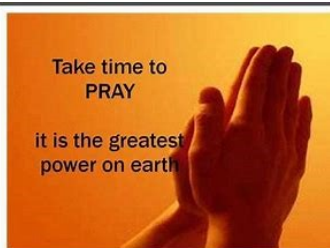

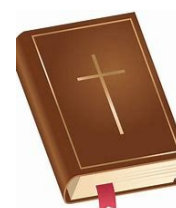

Women's Bible Study

The women's Thursday night Bible study meets Thursday evenings at 6:30 on Zoom. All women are welcome to join us! Use Holy Lamb's standard meeting code. We are using the reading plans provided at www.shereadstruth.com. You can find the daily Scripture readings and devotion at their website or sign up for their daily email or download their app. The website and emails are free; some of the plans on the app have a nominal charge. There is also a weekly podcast that discusses that week's readings. *We would love to have you join us! And whether or not you meet with us, this can be another easy way to develop a daily Bible reading habit. (For those men who are feeling 'left out', there is also a 'He Reads Truth' reading plan at the website!)*

We are studying the book of **Exodus**, the story of God's all-encompassing salvation. He delivers the people of Israel from oppression in Egypt to establish them as a community to whom and through whom He would make Himself known. *We are all surprised at how much more we are seeing in these events that we thought we knew so well. It is amazing how much more you learn from God's Word when you slow down and read smaller sections every day!*

The week of August 22, we will begin a 3 week study called **Amen & Amen: A Journey Through the Psalms**. The book of Psalms is made up of five smaller books—individual songs and prayers compiled to tell one cohesive story for past, present, and future worshipers. We'll read selected psalms from each section to see how they contribute to the beauty of the compiled book. This overview of the Psalms will lift our eyes to the themes and patterns of the entire book, anchoring our worship in the legacy and future hope of our faith. Join us as we discover a framework for reading the Psalms as an invitation to worship our King, Jesus!

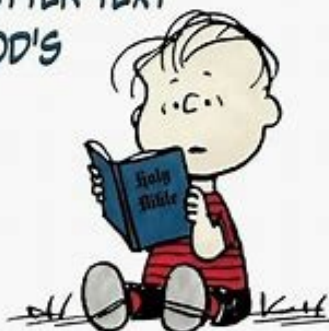
