While this new e-giving platform offers convenience, there is a small processing fee of 2.9%, as well as a \$0.45 per transaction fee. Example: If you wish to donate \$50 to Holy Lamb, covering the processing fee of 2.9% or \$1.45, plus the \$0.45 transaction fee, your total cost would be \$51.90 with Holy Lamb receiving \$50.
